

Yates Baptist Church  
Quarterly Church Conference  
October 17, 2012  
Minutes

Walt Pickett, Deacon Chair, called the quarterly conference of Yates Baptist Church to order on Wednesday, October 17, 2012 at 6:20 p.m.

Mr. Pickett presented the minutes of the quarterly church conference on July 18, 2012 and the called business meeting on September 12, 2012 for approval. Since the minutes were available on the church website and there was no request to have them read, a motion was made and seconded that these minutes be approved. The motion passed.

Nancy Wooters, Church Clerk, reported the following membership change requests:

Sean Fenton, Church Treasurer, reported that the church continues to be in the best financial condition it has been in a long while. At this time of year, cash flow is typically at its lowest point and the gap between income and budgeted expenses is greatest, and he encouraged the continued financial support of new and regular givers. Mr. Fenton stated that the Finance Committee is working diligently and faithfully on the 2013 budget, which will be available in a few weeks, and that he expects the church will be very pleased with their efforts.

Pastor Gordon reported on the election of messengers to the annual Yates Baptist Association and NC Baptist State Convention meetings. The church can send up to 10 members to each meeting, and in the past, members interested in serving as messengers have contacted the church office and submitted their names. Pastor Gordon made a motion to allow church members interested in serving as messengers this year to again be elected by contacting the church office and offering to serve. The motion was seconded and approved. Currently, John Saunders will be attending the NC Baptist State Convention meeting, which will be held November 13<sup>th</sup>-14<sup>th</sup>. Winslow Carter, John Frederick, Don Gordon, Michael Jessup, John Saunders and Gloria Wall will be attending the Yates Baptist Association meeting, which will be held on October 30<sup>th</sup>.

There was no further business, and the meeting was adjourned at 6:30 p.m.
